The gradual reopening of restaurants has applied to villages and towns (but not to big cities) from 1. 7. 2020 for municipalities authorized by the Colombian Ministry of the Interior. The restaurant reactivation strategy is carried out in non-covid municipalities and in regions of the national territory with few confirmed cases of coronavirus. The restaurants need to attend with all the protocols and respecting social distancing. In big cities, such as Bogota and Cartagena, some restaurants will re open starting 1. 8. 2020 (test mode).

Hotels in Colombia that comply with the biosecurity protocols of the Ministry of Health of that country will be able to acquire the "Together against Covid" seal. Only some hotels in villages and towns are opened (test mode), following the biosecurity protocols. Extension of isolation: Mandatory preventive isolation is extended from 00:00 hours on 16. 7. 2020 to 00:00 hours on 1. 8. 2020 throughout Colombia. Shopping centers, museums and libraries may not exceed 30% of their capacity. The municipalities that are not affected may request the removal of the isolation. Authorized municipalities will not be able to hold events that crowd people, discotheques, bars or gastronomic venues won't open. Starting on 21. 7. 2020, in the municipalities with low involvement of covid-19, pilot tests will be carried out for domestic flights. International flights are supposed to operate again as of 1. 9. 2020.

To enter Denmark, tourists from the approved countries must show documentation of a valid booking for a minimum of 6 days on entry.
